# **Strategic Plan Update**

FSC CEO Ann-Marie Balliana discussed key areas of the Strategic Plan Priorities document provided to the Board.

# Representative and Development Council Update

- The first meeting of the Council was held on 9<sup>th</sup> April at the FSC Offices with attendance from Bobby Mazevski (President of the South Coast Wolves), Mick Woods (Presidents Illawarra Stingrays), Walter Del (President – Taipans) and Joe Seco (FSC Junior Council Member and Development Program Coordinator)
- Bobby was elected as the Head of this council.
- A workshop will be scheduled with the council to be facilitated by Bob Hennessey with the council members to outline the strategies of this new council.

## Governance

- Finance reports were submitted and approved
- Sign off on the Business Conduct and Ethics document to be rolled out across all councils
- Interviews have been scheduled for the Independent review of the FSC Board with all board members

#### Infrastructure Update

- A meeting has been scheduled with FNSW to identify any potential assistance
- Meetings to be scheduled with each of the State MP's to discuss funding options
- Ongoing assessment of funding options and application openings

## Juniors Football Council – Danielle Foster

- Some logistical issues in relation to the U18 competition which are being addressed
- A meeting to be held with Shellharbour Council around the use of facilities

## Men's Football Council

- The competition review paper has been finalised and sent to all clubs.
- Men's meetings have been combined to form one Men's Football Council meeting.
- Men's Council is working closely with the Referee's Council to address the number of catch up games
- Games will be rescheduled as much as possible to avoid conflict with South Coast Wolves home games

## Women's Football Council

• Discussions to take place between the Junior and Women's council on how to manage the transition from junior to women competitions.

# Referee Council

- FSC Board discussed the consideration of a sub-committee to look at strategies on increasing referee numbers.
- Sub-committee to consist of representatives across all councils and to be facilitated by a Board Member.
- Assistance will also be sought from the FFA and FNSW
