Update from the FNSW Town Hall Meeting Update

- FNSW mentioned a cap on the FFA fee in 2014 for associations
- Lots of positive discussion around Junior Development programs i.e. SAP was a very positive initiative from all associations.

Infrastructure

- State Government Update - Restart NSW Illawarra Infrastructure Submission - confirmed 124 projects submitted to the State Government which has been reduced to 20 of which FSC was one.
- FNSW and FFA have both stated they will support the Home of Football which will be the major facility in the Region not only to hold local competitions but also National and State tournaments. This will provide economic growth to the Illawarra.
- Confirmed Federal Funding approval has been received to build the Home of Football Complex, which will be done in stages. \$7.4million represents 50% of the funding from the Federal Labour Government and the remainder of the funding to be sought from the State Liberal Government will complete the whole project costing 14.8million.

- Meetings were held with several Clubs to guide them through the process

Matilda Coach Visit – coaching clinic

- The Matildas Coach conducted coaching clinic (theory and practical) held at Wollongong University which were a success with great feedback from all attendees.
