Strategic Plan Update

- Document taken as read
- Discussions to be held with various sponsors over the coming months
- The Futsal competition is to be rebranded “Five A Side Football” with updated competition playing rules being developed and to be communicated to all teams for 2015
- A Coaching Club Representative paper was presented which was outlined as an opportunity to provide a coaching pathway and ensure that clubs are provided with the tools and techniques to improve the quality of club coaching
- FSC coaches are available to assist clubs with grading and requested the Junior Football Council to advise clubs of this.
