Note 2: Junior Referees need to Over 16 to be appointed as an Assistant Referee in a Senior Game and Over 18 to be appointed to as (Centre) Referee.

Appendix 1:

- First Offence \$50 fine
- Subsequent Offences 100% of match fees and will be requested to attend a meeting with the Referee Council to explain their actions

Any fines incurred by members will be removed from the member's next match pay. This is for ease of administration. If said member is not due any match payments, said member will be invoiced accordingly.

Volunteer Referees

- Volunteer Referees are not registered with FSC and may or may not have any refereeing qualification or not appointed by FSC for senior games and junior club coordinators for junior games
- Examples of a volunteer Referee include, but is not limited to:
 - A parent running a line on a junior game.
 - A substitute running a line because the home club was unable to appoint
 - An Ex-Referee who has not renewed qualifications.
- Volunteer Referees are not allowed to wear Referee apparel with the FSC logo.
- All Volunteer Referees must wear a brightly coloured bib that does not clash with the playing strips of the two teams or goalkeepers.
