Subject: Community League Playing Calendar (Draft) + Registration Timing

Dear Community League Clubs,

Thank you for registering your Expression of Interest to participate in the 2021 Football South Coast Community League. We will continue to liaise with any clubs who are either missing information or have an incomplete submission.

We have attached the draft 2021 Playing Calendar for your reference however please note that this is subject to change.

Please find below the timing for formal team nominations, registration, fee collection, grading appeals and League declaration.

4 Jan – 17 Feb	<b>Team Nominations</b>   Clubs are required to register a minimum 11 players per team and place them in their respective teams in Play Football.
3 Feb	<b>Peter Webster Cup Team Nomination</b>   We will provide you with the nomination form, regulations, and proposed format in mid-January.
18 Feb	<b>Nomination Fees</b> i.e., \$300 per team <b>must</b> be paid to Football South Coast. Team nomination form and team lists also due. This will be provided to clubs early in the new year.
25 Feb	<b>Draft Competition Structure</b>   FSC will provide club the proposed divisional structure based on 2020 performance and calibre of registered players. Clubs will have to 1 Mar to submit an appeal on their allocation to a division.
2 Mar	<b>Grading Appeals Meeting</b>   FSC will host an appeals meeting for any club(s) dissatisfied with their allocation. This will be open to all clubs.
5 Mar	<b>League Declaration</b>   FSC will formalise the League structure, declare the Leagues and get started on the draw(s).

Clubs will need to set their own products/packages in Play Football for 2021. The system will automatically roll over 3 January for the 2021 season with those that have active products available to players looking to register.

Clubs/teams that do not conform to these timing requirements may have their team nomination rejected.

Just a reminder that David Ware and I will be back online from 11 January 2021. The FSC Office will reopen on 18 January 2021.
