Role: Men's Referee Coordinator

Reports to: Referees Coordination Council (RCC)

How does the job add value?

- The role ensures referees are appropriately allocated to control games in the Men's competition
- Manages the relationship and addresses issues with the Men's Council
- Ensures referees meet the standards required by senior referees

Role Objectives:

- In conjunction with the RCC, implement the new structure
- Achieve a workable appointments process
- Sufficient referees/AR's to meet desired requirements
- Effective Development pathways in place
- Respected and workable relationship with the Senior referees and Men's Council
- Overall improvement in the standard (performance on the park and appropriate behavior) of referees
- Assist in the implementation of the Member Protection Policy

Role Deliverables

- 70 registered senior referees
- Implementation and enforcement of the Withdrawals Policy
- Ensure compliance with Communication Guidelines
- All enquires/issues are dealt with in an appropriate time frame
- Appointments process accepted by all members
- Demonstrated improvement in standard (performance on the park and appropriate behavior) of referees

Dimensions

- The role is defined by all matters associated with Men's referees

Authorities

- Prime responsibility for the appointments to Men's matches
- Direct FSC Administration Staff as required

Accountabilities

- Maintain and enhancement of the standard of FSC referees
