FA, Football NSW and FSC have now completed the season rollover process for the Registration types in preparation for the 2022 Football season.

For most clubs, the process will simply require you to migrate your 2021 products to 2022 and then adjust your club fee. In some cases, you may need to create a new product.

Men's Premiership clubs will need to do their own setup this season.
