Members

We received from your Club in November 2023, an expression of interest to nominate teams in the Community League Competitions for 2024.

As part of the nomination process, your club must supply the name and email address of the person who will be the team referee. A copy of the information sent previously can be found on the FSC website in club correspondence.

Your club should be actively getting players registered in Play Football and will need to confirm your participation by nominating teams into the respective competitions (All Age, Masters, and/or Over 45's) by **COB on 15 February 2024**.

The club must by this date have:

- Submitted the online nomination form – which includes the name and email address of the team referee for every team nominated.
- Paid \$330 nomination fee per team and
- Based on nominations have in Dribl allocated a minimum of
 - 22 players to each All-Age team nomination (2 grades)
 - 11 players to single All Age team nomination (Div 3)
 - 11 players to each Master's team nomination
 - 11 players to each O45 team

Note – All Age 2 grades, the team nomination is \$660 as it is 2 teams!

Page 2 – You will need to enter the number of teams in each of the following categories – and provide additional information, including the name of the team referee and their email address.

All Age Teams – 2 grades
All Age Team – 1 grade,
Masters,
O45.

If you are not entering a team in a category, put 0.

Where you indicate one or more teams in a category then you will be asked for the requested division for team AAM A or Masters A, and an opportunity to put in a reason for requesting a division and/or give additional information which includes the name of team if different from the club's name (e.g. Hogs) and/or indicating if your preference is to play home matches on Friday night . Similarly, for AAM B or Masters B etc.

A question will ask if your club about participating in the Peter Webster Cup. Note - first grade team only for All Age.

Nomination Fees

Your club must by COB on 15th February 2023 have paid the nomination fee.

If you are using a Bank Transfer, then ensure your reference is **Club** Men CL nomination. Please send David a copy of the receipt of the bank transfer (davidware@footballsouthcoast.com)

Allocation of Players in Dribl

1. Players must be made Active in Play Football. Do not make a player active unless your club has received payment of the registration fees as the Club will be liable for the governing body component.
2. Once a player is Active then data from PF will come across to Dribl, usually overnight but in peak period could take up to 48 hours.
