Dribl is now ready for clubs to form teams for the 2025 season.

The Men's and Women's Premier League teams have already been created as their competitions were finalised in 2024.

For Community Club adult teams, your club will need to create each team.

Use the following information when you create teams in Dribl.

If there are 2 or more teams in the same age group AND division then distinguish the teams in group. For example – In Community League Uni has Bomb Brewers and Spurs.

Please note the following when creating teams.

Divisions

U6 – 12 as per table. For U13 to U18, choose preferred division.

Group

All mini roo teams (U6 - 11) will require a colour.

A club who has 2 or more U12 teams must use "A" in group for strongest team, "B" for next strongest, etc. A club who has 1 U12 team must use A in group.

Similarly for 12 Girls.

Gender

There are only two gender options to use:

Girls only comps – Female. All other comps – mixed.

Allocating Players Men's and Women's Premiership

Players are to be allocated once to the grade they are most likely to play, i.e. FG, SG or YG.

All players registered are to be allocated to teams by COB 26 February 2025. Team lists will then be locked.

Allocating Players Men's and Women's Community Adult Competitions

Men's Community All Age Competitions - 2 Grades

Please allocate players **once** to the grade that they would most likely play each week. Each team requires a minimum of 14 players allocated.

Men's and Women's Community All Age Competitions – Single teams in divisions.

Please allocate players **once** to their respective team, noting that the minimum number required is 14 players. There is no maximum, however clubs should understand that borrowing rules have changed and whilst there is no limit in the number of players being borrowed, there is a restriction where the players come from.

Men's and Women's Master's Competitions – Single teams in Divisions

Please allocate players **once** to their respective team, noting that the minimum number required is 14 players. There is no maximum, however clubs should understand that borrowing rules have changed. Players in O30W, 35M Division 1 teams cannot be borrowed to the lowest AA competition we run. For example, if the lowest AAW Competition is Division 3 then players in O30 Women Div 1 cannot be borrowed to the AAW Div 3 teams.

There is no limit in the number of players being borrowed, however there is a restriction where the players come from.

NOTE – When teams are locked and graded then regrading of any player to a lower division will require correspondence from the Club explaining the reasons. Clubs will initially only be permitted to have three successful regrading applications. Once a player is regraded (up or down) when team lists are locked then they are ineligible to be regraded again.

Team nominations

All adult community league team nominations are required by **COB 23 February 2025** and at least 14 players allocated to each team. Teams will be locked at this point in Dribl.

Allocating Player to Junior Community Competitions

Junior Competitions

Please allocate players **once** to their respective team, noting that the minimum number required is 11 players for U13 – U18 competitions and maximum is 16 players.

For U12 competitions, the minimum is 9 players and maximum is 14 players.

Mini Roos

Please allocate players **once** to their respective team. Whilst there is no maximum, teams must adhere to the maximum number of players allowed on match day. For example, if a U9 team has 12 players registered, then 11 players only can be used on match day. The 12th player could be borrowed to another team U9 team that the Club has.

Team Nominations

- Junior competition required by COB 23 February 2025 and at least 11 players allocated to each team. Teams will be locked at this point in Dribl. Any dispensation requests for player movement also due 23 February 2025.
- Mini Roos required by **COB 13 March 2025** and players allocated teams by 16 March 2025. Teams will be locked at this point in Dribl.
