We have been advised of the FA and FNSW fees for 2026 and the FSC Board has approved the FSC Fee as follows:

Key Notes:

1. FA have increased their 2026 fees by the following:
Juniors \$3.00, Amateur adults \$7.00, Professional adults \$7.00
2. As a result of the revised FNSW Insurance Program, FNSW has chosen to freeze the Capitation and Insurance amount due to a secured savings across the whole insurance program. Slight increase of \$1.70 in adults.
3. FSC have increased fees by \$3.00 per player for the 2026 season after having not increased fees in 2025. This is due to inflation, increased usage costs of the DRIBL competition management system and operational expenses to manage the significant growth of our competitions.
4. We have realigned the fee structure into categories of Community and Premier League Competitions, as a result the Community League Category of players 16-19 now falls within a lower fee structure.
5. The total is the sum of all fees in the table which has been rounded.
