Subject: Last Registrations for 2026

Members

Tuesday 30th June is the last day for:

- Players to be registered in Play Football
- Requests for Regrading Players
- Listing any Unfinancial Player
- Refund requests with FSC

To facilitate the above, the following information is provided / required

Late Registrations:

Players must be approved by the club in Play Football, no later than 1 July. The participant must have paid at least the governing body fees as required.

In the case where an amateur player is moving clubs, then it is recommended that the deregistration process needs to be started in Play Football, no later than Sunday 22 June.

Regrading Players

Please read the respective competition rules in relation to borrowing for the final's series.

In Junior, All Age or Masters competitions, a regrade letter must be submitted outlining the reasons why the club is seeking to move players to lower age groups or divisions. There is no guarantee that these regrade request will be approved.

Late Registration Form

Please use this form for regrade requests (June 30) and players who you haven't been able to map (July 4). The form will be not available after Friday 4 July.

Unfinancial Players

I remind members of Article 15 from the FSC Registration Regulations. Also attached with this Memorandum is the FNSW policy.

15 UN-FINANCIAL PLAYERS

15.1 ACCEPTING PART PAYMENT

1. Clubs who accept “Subsidised Payment” option or “Regulations Fees Upfront” option from a Participant would organise fee payment(s) to be made directly to the Club.
2. Clubs who accept “Subsidised Payment” may need to pay on behalf of the Participant, the Governing Body Fees in FARS as per [Article 13-4](#).
3. If a Club agrees with the Participant on part payments for fees, then a written document from the Club is to be provided to the Participant which outlines the agreed schedule of payment, including payment periods which should conclude by 31 May of the current season.
4. Where a Participant has an overdue payment, the Club is to send official correspondence to the Participant, asking for payment within seven days and that they shall be stood down from Matches if payment is not received from that date.
5. Where the Participant requests an extension of a payment deadline and is agreed to by the Club, then correspondence from the Club to the player should confirm this and the new deadline.
6. Where payment is not made in accordance with [Articles 15.3 or 15.4](#) above, the Club will send official correspondence, informing the Participant that payment has not been received and that the Participant is stood down from participating in Matches until the payment is paid.

15.2 LISTING A PLAYER AS UN-FINANCIAL WITH FSC

1. Clubs who wish to list Players as un-financial with FSC must provide all correspondence between the parties including information outlined in [Article 0](#) no later than 30 June of the current season.
2. FSC will not list Players as un-financial if Clubs allow players to participate in Matches after 31 May unless there are very exceptional circumstances.
3. Where the conditions in [Article 0](#) or [Article 15.2 above](#) are met then FSC shall list the Player as un-financial and send correspondence to both the Player and the Club in regards to this matter.
4. A Player who is un-financial will not be eligible to participate in any Match in any role.

Registration Refund Requests – FSC Component

Any refund request on behalf of participants need to be commenced in Play Football prior to June 30.
